Student-Staff Communication Guidelines

1. Guiding principles of communication

- a) Focus on School-related issues or informing teachers about important matters
- b) Minimize disruption to your teachers' teaching and other school duties
- c) Respect teachers' rest time outside of school operating hours (7:30 a.m. 5:30 p.m. weekdays)
- d) Use respectful language

2. These are the official channels to contact your teachers:

- a) Teachers' ICON email addresses (with domain name @moe.edu.sg)
- b) School General Office phone: 6466 7705 (you may leave a message for your teacher)
- c) You may also approach your teachers face-to-face in School
- 3. Students should keep communication with teachers within acceptable hours from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., during weekdays and school term.
- 4. *If your teachers have shared their phone numbers and given you permission*, you may contact them for urgent and important matters through phone calls or text messages.
- 5. Acceptable reasons to contact your teachers via the phone include:
 - a) If you are late for school or feeling unwell
 - b) Reporting serious issues to your teacher
 - c) Other urgent matters
- 6. Address your teachers politely at all times. Use proper, acceptable language. Avoid slangs, short forms or abbreviations.
